
# More Kiwis Expected At Food & Wine Fest

Organisers of the fifth annual Hawai'i Food and Wine Festival are expecting more New Zealanders at this year's event, due to the festival's higher profile in this market—and the continued Kiwi demand for all things Hawaiian.

The event is on 29 Aug-13 Sep and features over 80 renown master chefs (including New Zealand's own Michael Meredith) staging events across the island group. The line-up includes showcases on Hawai'i Island, Maui and in Honolulu and Ko Olina on Oʻahu.
