Kiwi Travel To Hawaii Steady

Kiwi travel to Hawaii remains steady as the rainbow state announces record visitor arrivals of 720,997 for Jan, up 6.2% year-on-year—and the 11th consecutive month that the destination has achieved record arrivals.

The Oceania region showed growth with Jan visitor arrivals up 2.2% (to 32,422) year-on-year. And while Kiwi arrivals were 3985 for the month in review (down 0.3%) Hawaii Tourism New Zealand manager Darragh Walshe points out that arrivals have held steady on Jan 2015, which was a record month, and up 24% on Jan 2014.

"We are expecting another strong year for Kiwi travel to Hawaii," says Walshe. "We will have extra capacity when Air New Zealand moves to 787

services between Auckland and Hawaii in May, and anecdotal feedback is still very positive."

Record arrivals to Hawaii does mean that it would pay for agents to book clients with specific requests (dates or properties) well in advance, says Walshe, to avoid disappointment.

Total visitor expenditure in Hawaii for Jan was up 2.9% to \$1.5 billion for Jan and arrivals to Oahu were up 8.2%; to Maui, up 1%; to Hawaii Island up 3.8%, and arrivals to Kauai slipped 2.7%, year-on-year.

... Pro-active

While it is reporting record arrivals, Hawaii Tourism is far from complacent. "... history has taught us time and again that success for Hawaii tourism can never be assumed," says the NTO's chief executive George Szigeti. "It's imperative we continue to be aggressive with our marketing of the Hawaiian Islands, while showing visitors the aloha and unique experiences they come here to enjoy."


