Hawaii's premier cultural event is set to return in 2018, showcasing the rich blend of Asia, Pacific and Hawaiian culture to the rest of the world.

The Annual Honolulu Festival is set to be held 09-11 Mar, with the theme of Harmony over the Ocean, Journey to Peace. The show will feature performers from around the world, including Philippines, Australia, South Korea and Japan. Highlighted events during the festival include educational school tours, a friendship gala, a craft fair which will feature over 100 national and international vendors, stage performances from cultural groups, the Honolulu Rainbow EK-IDEN Kick Off Night dance convention, a rainbow relay race, as well as a Grand Parade and Nagaoka Fireworks.
