A Guide To Exploring Hawaii's West Side

Kauai's west is home to Waimea Canvon State Park. Also known as the 'Grand Canyon of the Pacific'

the 9100m canyon offers breath-taking views, and can be further explored at outdoor enthusiast 'mecca' Kokee State Park.

Over on Oahu's west side the Waianae Coast is said to feature some of the island's most beautiful sunsets and best underwater activities. Home to the largest population of Native Hawaiians, Waianae offers traditional Hawaiian values and practices as well as a number of ecologically-conscious water adventures in which clients can spot turtles, whales and dolphins.

Lahaina, on west Maui, is famed for



having some of the best whale watching in the world. Whale watching tours are available from Lahaina Harbor Jan-early Apr. Clients who would rather stay on land can head to Outlets of Maui for a spot of designer shopping at discounted prices.

In keeping with the wildlife theme, Hawaii Island's western Kona Coast is the best place in Hawaii for spotting manta rays. Clients who want to get closer to the rays, which can reach up to 6m long, can opt for a night boat tour in which they can swim with these gentle giants.
