Following a USD15 million renovation, the former Residences at Kapalua Bay has re-opened as the Montage Kapalua Bay, a new all-suite property on the northwest coast of Maui.

The property spans 24 acres and features 50 luxurious residentialstyle suites, ranging from one to four bedrooms. Each room features large 'lanais' (balconies) with ocean views, full gourmet kitchens, signature Montage bedding, spacious living area and a washer and dryer. The resort also features signature

Hawaii is looking at ways to improve access to its harbours and accommodate more cruise ships throughout the islands following an 18.9% decline in cruise business Jan-Apr, says the Hawaiian Tourism Authority. It recently issued a request for proposals for maritime vessel scheduling software, which would help establish a vessel scheduling system to optimise the use of dock space and accommodate more cruise ships.
