It features 155 miles of trails and 66 miles of paved roadways, and is also home to Kiauea, one of earth's most active volcanoes which is presently erupting from two locations (Halema'uma'u Crater and the Pu'u'o'o vent). When To Visit

Any time of the year is a good time to visit Hawaii, says Hawaii Tourism. Summer, Apr-Nov, is warmer and drier (average temperature is 24°-31°C) while winter, Dec-Mar is a bit cooler (20°-27°C). Trade winds keep things comfortable year-round.

Whale watching season is late Decearly May, and peak whale watching months are Jan-early Apr. The legendary big wave season on Hawaii's North Shore beaches is Nov-Feb.



The Royal Treatment

Iolani Palace in downtown Honolulu offers an insight into Hawai'i's colourful history. It's the only royal palace in the US and when it opened in 1882 the palace actually had electric lights and telephones before the White House. Guided and self-guided tours are available and bookings are recommended. The palace is a 15 min. drive from Waikiki or around 30mins by bus (bus 2, 3 or B City Express from Kuhio, Wakiki to Beretania and Punchbowl St). See iolanipalace.org
