
Clients staying in the upgraded Ali'i Tower receive a host of value-add inclusions such as:

Children are permitted in the Ali'i Tower, and inter-connecting rooms are available for families and groups. However the tower, especially the pool, is a tranquil area. Perhaps the best perk is the access to the private pool. Ali'i guests can still use the resort's other pools, and those with families tend to opt for the bigger pools (such as the Paradise Pool with its four water slides). This means there's plenty of loungers and a sense of calm at the Ali'I pool-which also enjoys all day sun thanks to its beachfront location away from other buildings.

The Village

The Hilton Hawaiian Village is the area's only beachfront resort. There's five pools, the Duke Kahanamoku Lagoon and more than 90 shops including 18 restaurants and bars.

Tropics bar and grill is traditionally touted as the best place in the village to take in Waikiki's legendary sunsets—but the tower's Ali'i MixBar is located just two floors above the Tropics, offering the same view and its own signature cocktails but without the crowds. It's also an ideal spot to take in the resort's weekly Fri night fireworks display from 1945. Urge clients to sample the Mixbar's signature cocktail a ono pop prosecco (pictured) which features a local artisan fruit ice-block served in a glass of Prosecco.

Signature Scent

The Ali'i Tower offers a private checkin and concierge—and a signature scent. Once guests come through the doors into the tower lobby the tower's signature fragrance wafts around. In fact the scent generated so many positive comments from the Ali'I Tower guests that a diffuser is now on sale from the tower's front desk, so clients can take home a reminder of their stay.

Ali'l Library

Clients can also use utilise the dedicated concierge located in the library area in the lobby of the tower. Here guests can access free Wi-Fi, print boarding passes and more, while the concierge can book activities or preferred reservations at the on-site restaurants (including those that don't normally take bookings).
