



Hawaii's Celebration Of Music, Culture



Hawaii's annual Mele Mei celebration of its famous music, dance and culture will return this year with performances at concert halls, hotels, restaurants and outdoor settings across the islands.

Mele Mei runs Apr-Jun and includes everything from ukulele to steel guitar, traditional Hawaiian music to slack key guitar, island reggae to hula, rock and more, culminating in the Na Hoku Hanohano Awards.

As well as music and hula events, other options for clients keen to experience Hawaii's music include the free Kamaka Hawaii Ukulele Factory Tour, which tells the story of how Kamaka ukuleles have been made by hand for the last 100 years. See kamakahawaii.com

Hawaii's food trucks have earned something of a cult following, from the shrimp trucks on Oahu's North Shore to pop up events around the islands— however an eclectic mix of food trucks have now set up residence in Waikiki. The Pau Hana Market is open daily and is essentially a food truck food court, offering everything from acai bowls, hot dogs and gourmet burgers to plate lunches, garlic shrimp, poke and ramen. The Pau Hana Market is located at 234 beach Walk in Waikiki (next to the Trump hotel and across from the Embassy Suites) and has fast become a favourite with locals and visitors alike.
