Hawaii's oldest food festival, the Kona Coffee Cultural Festival, returns this 07-16 Nov with new events like Kona coffee farm tours, native Hawaiian arts and culture, and child-friendly activities.

Coffee has been grown on Hawaii Island since the early 1800s but by the second half of the 19th Century it focused mainly on the Kona district, where large coffee plantations flour-

ished until the coffee market crashed in 1899

Japanese immigrants then leased the land in plots and created their own family-run farms, and today around 600 independent Kona coffee farms continue to operate.

Highlights of the 10-day festival, which has been around for 44 years, include the Kona Coffee Cupping Contest, Kona Coffee Belt Farm Tours, coffee picking and recipe contests, a living history farm tour to experience life on a 1920s coffee farm, and the Kamehameha Schools Ho'olaule'a celebration of art, food, music and fun. Hawaii Airports Upgrade

Hawaii is to pour more than USD335 million into improving its airports, including upgrading the concessions at Honolulu and upgrading the Overseas Terminal, used by airlines like Air New Zealand and Fiji Airways.

The funds are designed to 'improve the air travel experience' for visitors and transform the islands' airports into world-class facilities, says governor Neil Abercrombie.

The money will go towards building a car rental facility at Kahului Airport on Maui, roadway improvements at the Overseas Terminal at HNL, creating an extra 2600m² of concession space at HNL's Ewa Concourse (there's currently just 480m²), and improving aircraft rescue and firefighting facilities at Hilo International Airport.
