The event celebrates the history and tradition of May Day, as well as honouring the Waikiki Beach Boys, a special group who are licensed in all levels of surf handling including surf lesson instruction, outrigger canoe rides, stand up paddle lesson instruction, and catamaran sailing.

This year the event will recognise Waikiki Beach Boys Alex Apo, who worked on the beach for 44 years and was one of the original beach boys; and Richard Kapela Kauo, who passed away in 2013 and pioneered the 'hot curl' style of surfing. Working as a lifeguard and surfing instructor, he's most fondly remembered for spending his later years greeting visitors at Duke's Waikiki.

This free event will also include a concert with Ambassador of Aloha Danny Kaleikini, award-winning contemporary reggae-pop vocalist Anuhea and hula dancers from local hula halau. There will be free canoe rides in front of the Royal Hawaiian Hotel from 1000-1400.

Climbing Waterfalls

Rappel Maui has a new activity in the privately-owned Puohokamoa Valley of Jurassic Park fame, which involves walking backwards down waterfalls more than 10m high. The six-hour tour costs \$208.33 and includes training, footwear, harness, backpack with dry keg, flotation jacket, helmet and lunch. Participants hike a short distance under a rainforest canopy for a briefing and demonstration and a practice 18m dry rappel down a jungle wall. After training participants rappel down two waterfalls into swimming pools. The hike is easy with total walking of about 1km with an elevation gain of about 91m. Participants must be at least ten years old. Details, rappelmaui.com
