

gade, with tour participants encouraged to use their phones if preferred. Operator Marie Turner says the company has seen an increasing number of Kiwis opting for the tours—which she partly attributes to the smaller group size, and off the beaten track itineraries.

The popularity of the tours, also mean there is a real need to prebook which is a great selling point for agents, she says, as well as a 20% referral fee for agents.

There are three main tours: sunrise, sunset (each USD85 and five hours long) and a full day tour (USD140). The longer nine-hour day tour is



the most popular and Turner says the circle island tour stops for an unhosted lunch and changes seasonally to take in the sights—such as the winter big waves on the North Shore. Each of the tours visit local beaches, sacred temples, the Ko'olau Mountains, a rainforest and a beach, and clients have the opportunity to create their own images and memories at each location.
