

Whale Watching Season From Nov



This weekend kicks off whale watching season in Hawaii, with humpback whales (known locally as kohola) usually able to be spotted cruising the warm waters from Nov-May.

There are plenty of whale watching cruise and tour options available, but those who aren't keen to get so close can also catch sight of the giants from the shore, says the Hawaii Tourism Authority.

Look-out points include Kauai's Kileauea Lighthouse, Oahu's Makapuu Lighthouse and Hawaii Island's Kohala Coast, where the whales are known to put on a show. The best whale-watching spots on Molokai and Lanai are from the south shores.

Maui hosts a Maui Whale Festival every winter, with World Whale Day as the highlight. Next year's World Whale Day is 15 Feb at the Kalama Park in Kihei, and the all-day festival includes food and entertainment. See mauiwhalefestival.org

Waikiki Farmers Market

The Pacific Beach Hotel, located in Waikiki has launched a new twice-weekly farmers market, on the corner of Waikiki's Kalakaua Ave and Liliuokanli Ave.

Maui Lu To Hilton

The Maui Lu Resort is set to be transformed into a Hilton Grand Vacations timeshare resort by 2017. The USD300 transformation of the 28-acre site will include 388 residences, gym and kids' section. The property also has 225m of beachfront.

Endless Summer Resort Planned

A 3.5-star Endless Summer Resort, inspired by the iconic 1960s surf film is reportedly planned for Oahu, which will be built around a four acre surfing wave pool.

Designed to appeal to travellers of all surfing abilities; the 'wave' will change in difficulty from 'remove the fear' for beginners to 'exceed the real thing' for advanced surfers. The developers have ambitious plans to open a 400-room resort by mid-2017—however a West Oahu site is reportedly yet to be selected. The property will offer accommodation from hotel room to overwater bungalows, but the location may not necessarily be oceanfront. The wave pool could reportedly accommodate up to 100 surfers at a time.
