Radio personality and 'Man About Town' Clarke Gayford ventured to the sunny Whitsundays for last weeks' episode of 'My Kind of Place'.

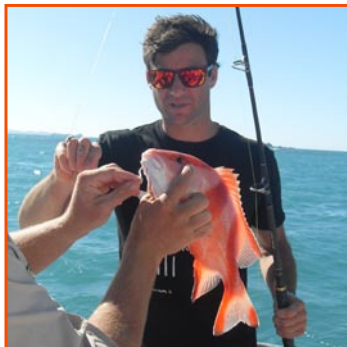
